

Terms of Use Agreement

These Terms of Use Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the Agreement) governs the relationship between Individual Entrepreneur Murashkin Dzmitry Rastislavavich (hereinafter referred to as IGNI, <https://igni.st.udio> or Administration) on the one hand, and the User of the website on the other hand. The UM website is not a mass media platform.

By using the site, you agree to the terms of this Agreement.

If you do not agree with the terms of this Agreement, do not use the IGNI website.

1. Subject of the Agreement

The Administration grants the User the right to post the following information on the website:

- text information;
- links to materials posted on other websites.

2. Rights and Obligations of the Parties

2.1 The User shall be entitled to:

- search for information on the website;
- receive information on the website;
- distribute information on the website;
- copy information to other sites with the permission of the copyright holder;
- require the Administration to hide any information transmitted by the User to the website;
- use the website information for personal non-commercial purposes;
- use the website information for commercial purposes with the permission of the copyright holders.

2.2 The Administration shall be entitled to:

- create, change, cancel rules at its discretion and when necessary;
- restrict access to any information on the website;
- create, modify, delete information from the website.

2.3 The User shall be obliged:

- not to disrupt the website's performance;
- not to use scripts (programs) for automated collection of information and/or interaction with the website and its services.

2.4 The Administration shall be obliged to:
maintain the website's functionality, except in cases when it is impossible for reasons beyond the control of the Administration.

3. Liability of the Parties

3.1 The Administration shall not be responsible for the discrepancy between the services expected by the User and the services actually received.

3.2 The Administration does not bear any responsibility for the services provided by third parties.

3.3 If a force majeure event occurs (military action, state of emergency, natural disaster, etc.), the Administration does not guarantee the safety of the information posted by the User, as well as the uninterrupted operation of the information resource.

4. Agreement Terms and Conditions

This Agreement enters into force with any use of this website.

The Agreement terminates when its new version appears.

The Administration reserves the right to unilaterally change this Agreement at its discretion.

The Administration does not notify the Users about any changes in the Agreement.
